# Official opening and prize-giving ceremony, location and course

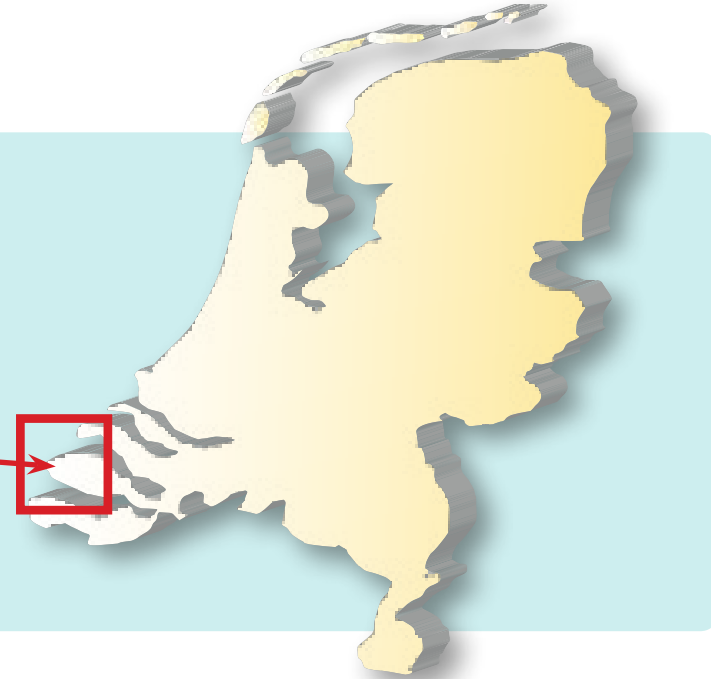
The official opening of the World Championship Shore Angling Youth 2015 will be held on October 17th at 15.30. In the afternoon, all teams leave 'Hof Domburg' for a parade through downtown Domburg, while they will be accompanied by the tones of djembéband Bedlam. After that, participants will be introduced to each other, locals, public and press by hoisting the flags of their countries and playing their national anthems. This will happen in the theatre 'De Parel' of Domburg.

At the end of the competition there will be a closing party and prize-giving ceremony on Thursday the 22nd of October. This will take place at theatre 'De Parel' and is accessible for press and public. After the prize-giving ceremony competitors, coaches, volunteers and guests are invited to a buffet and closing party.

# A-Category, Under 21

**JARNO MINDERHOUD (20), WESTKAPELLE AND MEMBER OF HSV WESTKAPELLE**

Individual Top-10 ranking (9th) at the World Championships 2013 in Spain and 4th at the National Topcompetition Shore Angling 2015. Came second in the 2012 Dutch Clubchampionship as a member of Team Westkapelle 2. "I hope the winter species, like dab and whiting, will show up at the World Championships venue. If they do, it will be a matter of casting as far as you can and I presume we will have a good chance of winning. Although the English team will be on our heels."



**LENNARD NOORTHOEK (21), SINT PHILIPSLAND AND MEMBER OF HSV DE MAKREEL**

Last year's World Champion with the National team in France and accomplished top-5 rankings at the National Topcompetition Shore Angling during the last three years. "If there is dab and whiting, we will be able to fish at long distance and we'll be favorite together with the English team. If these winter species are (almost) absent, we will have to fish at close range for small flounder, seabass and whatever swims in the surf. In that case all countries will have equal opportunities to win the title."



**JOERI MINDERHOUD (20), WESTKAPELLE AND MEMBER OF HSV WESTKAPELLE**



Looks back on winning a nice bronze medal with the National team in 2013 in Spain. He also won the National Topcompetition Shore Angling twice. "I think a good result for the Dutch team will depend on the presence of dab and whiting. Fish that will have to come from far. Although we shouldn't forget about fishing at short range. In October you will still find quite some flounder and seabass in the surf."

**MART VERHAGE (17), WESTKAPELLE AND MEMBER OF HSV WEST KAPELLE**

His best result is a silver medal and other high rankings at the National Topcompetition. Last year he became second in his sector at the Dutch Championships. "I expect both of our teams have a good chance of reaching the podium. I think we have a really strong team with a lot of experience in all different fisheries."



**KEES GILLISSEN (21), WESTKAPELLE AND MEMBER OF HSV WESTKAPELLE**



His best result is a double WC-gold and a bronze medal with the National team. He also won individual silver in 2012 in Montenegro plus high rankings at the National Topcompetition. "I hope we will be able to catch a lot of dab during the World Championships, for which you have to cast a good distance. We expect to get some strong opposition from England. They too are familiar with this type of fisheries."

**HENRI KARREMANS - NATIONAL COACH**

Most succesfull coach up to now, achieving 2 x gold, 2 x silver and 4 x bronze with both the junior teams and individual anglers between 2000 and 2014. Though not official, we are first in the ranking with this result. "This time we were able to select the best anglers available for this World Championship-course at both the U21 and U16 and I expect a duel between England and The Netherlands. The dab has already arrived in our coastal waters, so it will mainly become a fishery to which the English and we are accustomed to. So I don't want to hear about any lucky or unlucky drawings of lots. We are fully aiming at the podium!"



**FRANK PEENE - ASSISTANT-COACH**

Was a deserving member of several youth teams years ago. During this World Championships he is the assistant-coach to Henri Karremans.



# B-Category, Under 16

This youngest age category participates at the World Championships Shore Angling in Domburg for the first time ever. The WC-selection was compiled during the National championship. "We used a ranking list to do so", National coach Henri Karremans explains. "The first five in classification (Maarten van Beek, Machiel Wielaard, Mike Spee, Rik van Koevinge and Steff Bals) automatically qualified for the WC. Besides that we appointed two National youth coaches for the youngest category at this WC. Adriaan Dronkers and Corné Westelaken - who became Junior World Champion shore angling in 2012 in Montenegro - helped compiling the WC - team. Coming talent Maarten van Beek, who is only 12 years old, is the youngest member of the B-Junior team and became Dutch Champion at the B-juniors last year.

## Zeeland: the place to be
